

Using Ally to improve Accessibility – your privacy

Kristiania University College will introduce the <u>tool Ally</u> in all Canvas courses from spring 2023. Ally is a tool that supports content design according to <u>accessibility</u> requirements, and it gives students access to alternative content formats.

Kristiania University College – Ernst G. Mortensen Foundation is responsible for the processing of personal data in Ally. The tool is seen as necessary for the University College to meet the *legal obligation* we have to offer accessible content (the Anti-Discrimination and Accessibility Act).

Using the tool entails processing of all Canvas content (documents and pages). Student submissions and forum participation are not processed by Ally.

The tool will have access to user data such as Canvas ID, IP address and school email, as well as users' choice of alternative content formats. All such information is stored and transmitted only in an encrypted and anonymized format.
